

Membership Type: **INDIVIDUAL** – annual dues are \$50.00. Two year individual memberships are \$90.00 and three year individual memberships are \$125.00. The Young Adult membership for those people between 18-25 years old is \$15.00.

Definition: Any man or woman may become an INDIVIDUAL member of BCHC. This type of membership is best for singles or families whose members may have diverse interests. INDIVIDUAL memberships have one vote during general unit meetings. Young Adult is an individual membership type.

Individual memberships include subscriptions to unit newsletters, State newsletter and the National newsletter.

Membership Type: **FAMILY** (shared) - annual dues are \$60.00. Two year family memberships are \$110.00 and three year family memberships are \$150.00.

Definition: All family members living at the same address are eligible to participate fully in BCHC events. Only two members of each family type membership may vote in unit activities. A “shared” membership permits family members whose members have differing last names a BCHC membership as long as they all reside at the same address.

FAMILY memberships include one subscription to unit newsletters, State newsletter and the National newsletter.

Membership Type: **BENEFACTOR** – annual dues are \$100.00

Definition: All immediate family members are included within the Benefactor membership type. Two members of each benefactor membership can vote during general unit meetings.

Membership Type: **PATRON** – annual dues are \$250.00

Definition: All immediate family members are included within the Patron membership type. Two members of each patron membership can vote during general unit meetings.

Membership Type: **MT. WHITNEY** – annual dues are \$500.00

Definition: All immediate family members are included within the Mt Whitney membership type. Two members of each Mt Whitney membership can vote during general unit meetings.

Membership Type: **ASSOCIATE** – annual dues are \$15.00

Definition: All BCHC members who wish to contribute to and participate in other units activities are encouraged to become associate members of the “other” unit. You have to be a member in a primary unit as an individual, family, young adult, benefactor, patron or Mt. Whitney. You may have as many associate memberships as you wish. Associate membership does not give you a vote in the associate unit nor can you hold an officer position in the associate unit.
