

## Sawyer First Aid Kit

Forest Service Specification for a First Aid Kit:

There must be one first aid kit for each Sawyer Team.

**Type IV**: Intended for portable use in mobile industries and/or outdoor applications where the potential for damage due to environmental factors and rough handling is significant.

**Class B**: a broader range and quantity of supplies to deal with injuries in more complex or high-risk environments.

Most class B First Aid Kits on the market today do not have the quantities of each item that the Forest Service Specifications require. Check **your kit** against the list below.

Make sure you **restock** before each work party. (**LNT**: Plan ahead and prepare)
