Background check requirements with minors

**“If you are responsible for the care and discipline of a minor that is not your own” (family members excluded)
DOJ definition of Background check requirement**

BCHC Background Check Policy lists Camp counselors, Trail boss, Temporary Guardians required

Although not listed in policy, all adult member demonstrators or instructors in any youth specific event are highly recommended of getting their Youth Volunteer Card for their own level of protection against legal claims of negligence on the behalf of BCHC, even though you are not the responsible party of the minors present.

Public day event

Minors with parents

No action required

Minors with other family members

No action required for public day event

Youth membership minors with designated guardian

Must have parent signed permission form to participate in activity

If designated guardian is a family member no background check required

Day events members only

Youth membership with non member parent

No action required parent is the responsible party

Youth membership with other family member

Must have parent signed Parent permission form designating temp guardian

Youth membership with non family member guardian

Must have parent signed Parent permission form and background check required

Overnight events members only (Youth Summer camp refer to its own policy rules)

Minors with parents

No action required

Minors with other family members

Must have parent signed Parent permission form designating temp guardian

Youth membership with designated guardian

Must have parent signed permission form to participate in activity

If designated guardian is a family member no background check required
